Summer Educational Opportunities for Students who are Blind or Visually Impaired

Missouri School for the Blind (MSB) is pleased to offer Missouri students, who are blind or visually impaired, six summer sessions focused on developing students' abilities to access recreational sports, accessible travel, STEM (science, technology, engineering and math), performing arts, college and career planning, and activities of daily living with increased independence. Sessions are provided free of charge for qualifying students. Transportation and supervised residential housing are provided for students outside the St. Louis metro area during the week. Students return home on weekends.
