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All Home and Community Based Waivers: 18-month transition period of Behavior Analysis, Day Habilitation-Individual, Job Preparation services and Job Discovery ended

The Division of Developmental Disabilities (DD) had several service definitions in the currently approved Home and Community Based waiver applications that allowed for an 18-month transition beginning with the effective date of the waiver. Those services and limitations became effective February 28, 2019.

The Comprehensive and Community Support (CSW) Waivers 18-month services transition ended December 2017 and the Partnership for Hope (PfH) and Missouri Children's Developmental Disabilities (MOCDD) waivers 18-month services transition ended November 2018. Listed below are those services, procedure codes and modifiers that are no longer authorized or available.

This applies to all 4 waivers: Modifiers for Comprehensive (HI); Community (U1); MOCDD (HA); Partnership for Hope (HX).
