Introduction to Social Security Work Incentives

The Virginia Commonwealth University (VCU) National Training and Data Center recently announced a new web course that provides a basic introduction to the Social Security disability benefit programs (SSI and SSDI) and their associated work incentives. The free introductory course is designed to meet the training needs of those who want a better understanding of Social Security disability benefits and the basics related to how work affects these benefits. The target audience includes public agencies and employment service providers who support beneficiaries who wish to pursue employment. This two-week course consists of six (6) one-hour lessons including video lectures with slides, supplemental readings, resource tools and interactive activities.
