Missouri Autism Projects

In 1991, dedicated individuals made grass root efforts to establish family support services for individuals with autism and their families. As a result of these efforts, legislation was enacted (RSMo 633.330 and 9 CSR 45 - 3.060) that directed the Division of Developmental Disabilities (DD) to establish programs and services for persons with autism, and funding was secured for those statewide services. Missouri's five autism projects were established.
