Survey for Direct Support Professionals: Providing Support During the COVID-19 Pandemic

Like the people with disabilities they support, direct support professionals (DSPs) face a high risk of contracting COVID-19. They may also face financial hardship, exhaustion, and challenges in supporting their families.

The National Alliance of Direct Support Professionals (NADSP) and the Institute on Community Integration (ICI) have developed a survey to understand the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on DSPs. They also want to identify the most effective ways to protect DSPs and the people they support.
