## **Economic Income Payments for SSI Recipients**

The Social Security Administration has shared this message for Supplemental Security Income (SSI) recipients regarding the Economic Income Payments (EIP). If you receive SSI, you will get your \$1,200 economic impact payment from the IRS automatically - you don't have to do anything. EIP will not impact Medicaid or Social Security benefits.

- But if you get SSI, have not filed a tax return, and you have an eligible child, YOU MUST ACT NOW to get \$500 per child in addition to your \$1,200 payment
- BY MAY 5, go to the IRS' Non-Filer web form available at <a href="IRS.gov">IRS.gov</a> to give information about your children.
- If you miss the May 5 deadline, please go to IRS.gov for further information.
