National Disability Employment Awareness Month (NDEAM): An Essential Workforce

Nationwide, the <u>workforce participation rate</u> for individuals <u>with</u> disabilities has been less than half of the workforce participation rate for individuals <u>without</u> a disability. For people with *developmental disabilities*, the discrepancy is even greater with only 18% of individuals reporting employment, as measured by the <u>National Core Indicators</u> (an annual survey of services from public developmental disabilities agencies).

The COVID-19 pandemic has resulted in many changes for employees and job seekers with disabilities as well as those who support them. However, countless individuals with disabilities have been a part of the essential workforce to help communities and businesses remain strong. APSE, a national non-profit membership organization dedicated to Employment First for people with disabilities, is highlighting the stories of essential workers and the businesses who employ them as part of NDEAM.
