- Daily vaccination clinics are being held at the Dome at America's Center in St. Louis. They will be administering up to 3,000 doses per day for the next 8 weeks. The site is open from 8 am to 6 pm daily. Walk-ins are welcome or you can register through <u>Missouri's Vaccine Navigator</u>. There is free parking at 6th and Cole Streets with a shuttle available to take individuals to the Dome. The site is ADA compliant. They are offering Pfizer vaccine which is approved for those 16 and older.
- Vaccine clinics are being held Monday through Thursday at the Jefferson City Capital Mall for at least the next 4-6 weeks. The site is open from 9 am to 3 pm. Registrations are required at this time through Missouri's Vaccine Navigator but they hope to allow walk-ins very soon. They are offering Pfizer vaccine which is approved for those 16 and older.
