HCBS Enhanced Spend Plan

HCBS Enhanced Spend Plan Public Notice The American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA), signed into law in March, 2021, provides states an enhanced 10 percent increase in Federal Medical Assistance Percentage (FMAP) funding for certain Medicaid expenditures for home and community-based services (HCBS), provided certain requirements are met.

On Monday, July 12, 2021, The Department of Social Services/MO HealthNet Division (DSS/MHD) along with the Department of Health and Senior Services (DHSS) and the Department of Mental Health (DMH) submitted Missouri's spending plan and project narrative regarding the activities the state intends to implement to enhance, expand and strengthen home and community-based services related to the increased federal medical assistance percentage (FMAP).
