Registration is open for the next Family Support Partner (FSP) training. This training is for individuals who are being hired to work as a FSP and the staff who will be supervising the FSP in their agency. FSPs and supervising staff are required to complete the three day training prior to peer support services being provided to a family.

The next training will be held in-person at the Department of Mental Health in Jefferson City.

Trainings will occur 8:30 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. each day. Participants are required to attend all sessions. Click for the training flyer.
