People with intellectual and developmental disabilities (I/DD) are at a greater risk of infection and poorer COVID-19 related health outcomes than the general population. Differences in communication can sometimes create a hurdle to identifying and managing symptoms of COVID-19, especially for those experiencing the lasting effects of long-haul COVID.
