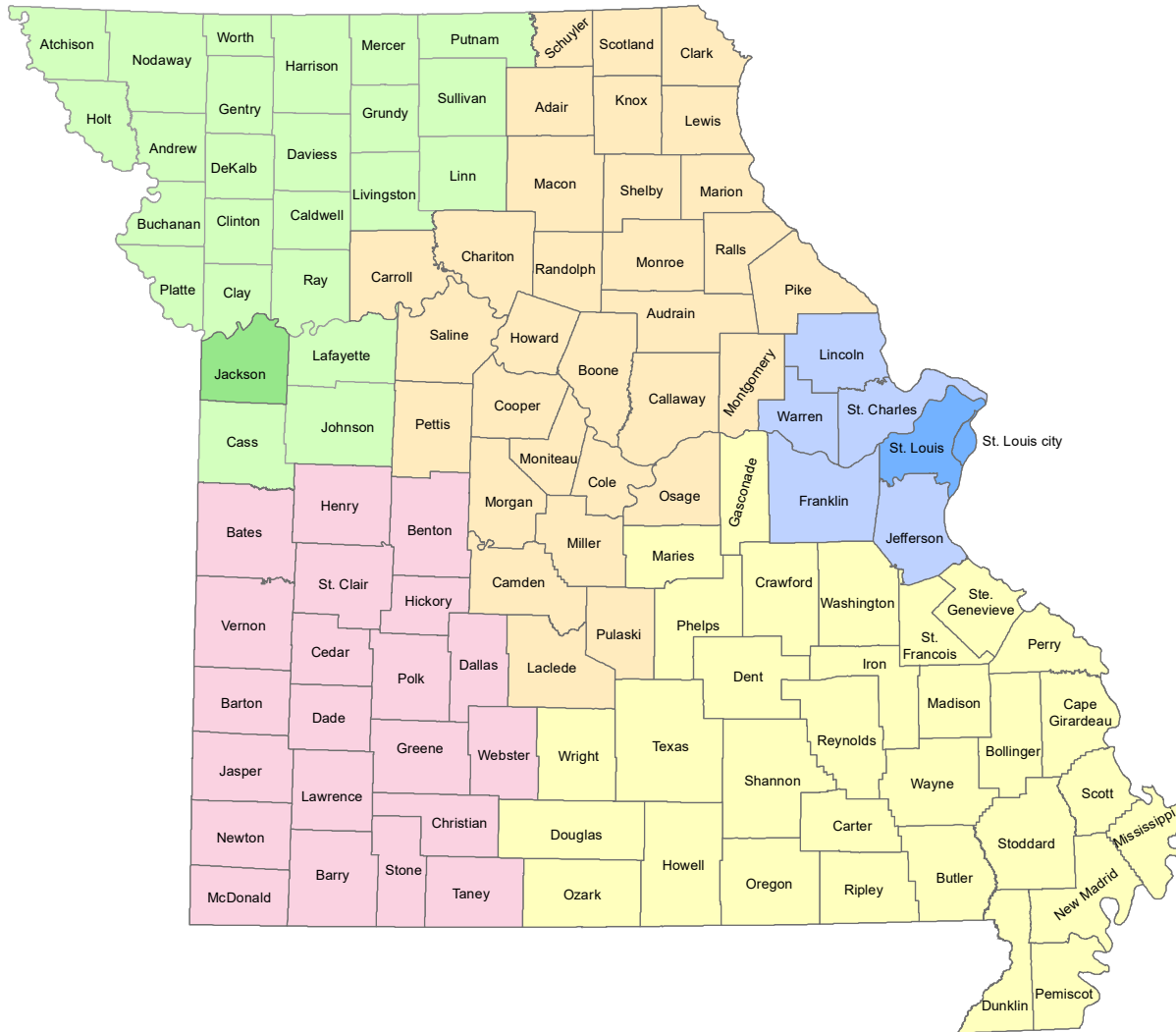

Missouri Sampling and Data Analysis Areas**



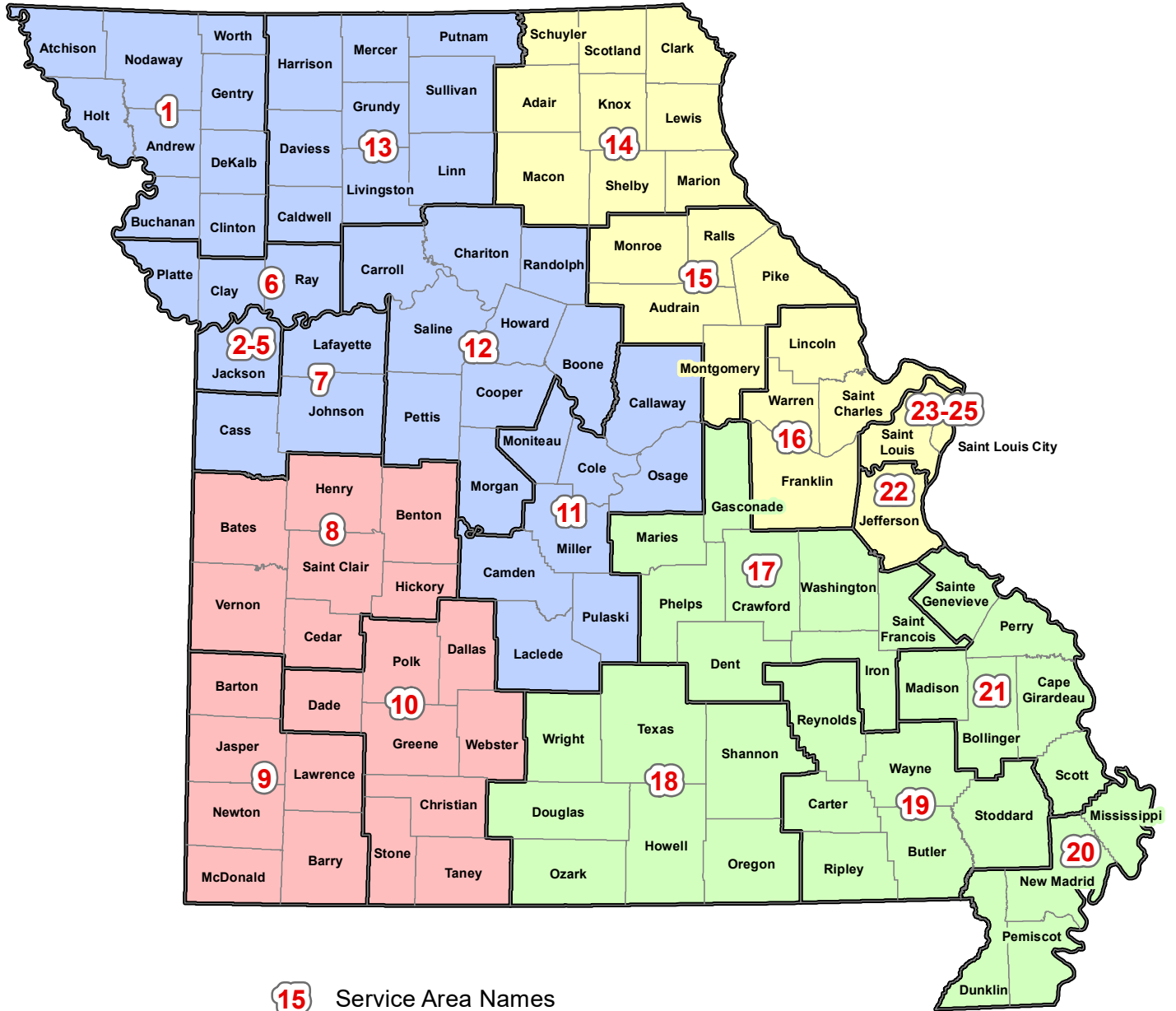

REGIONS AND SERVICE AREAS FOR SUBSTANCE USE SERVICES

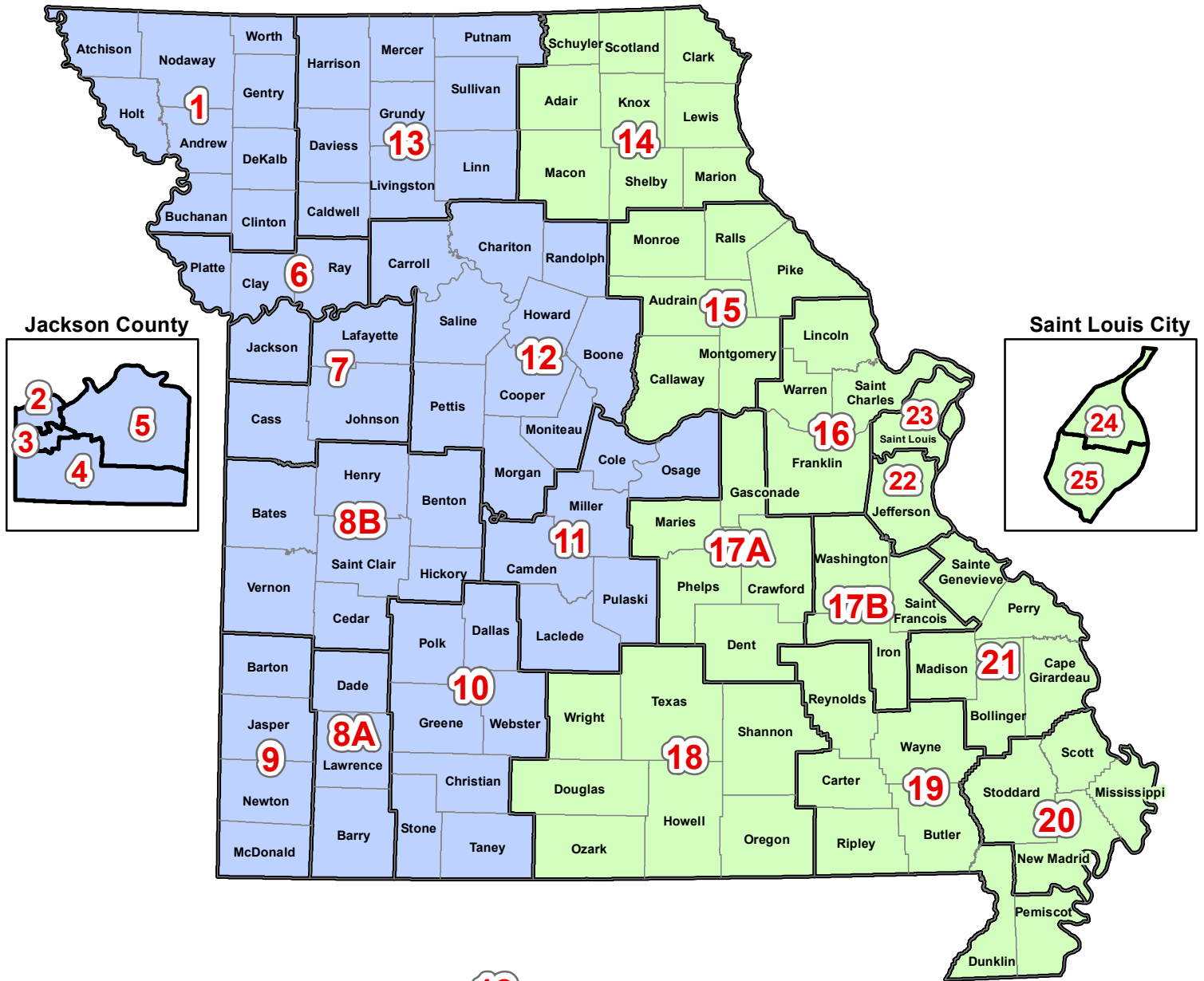

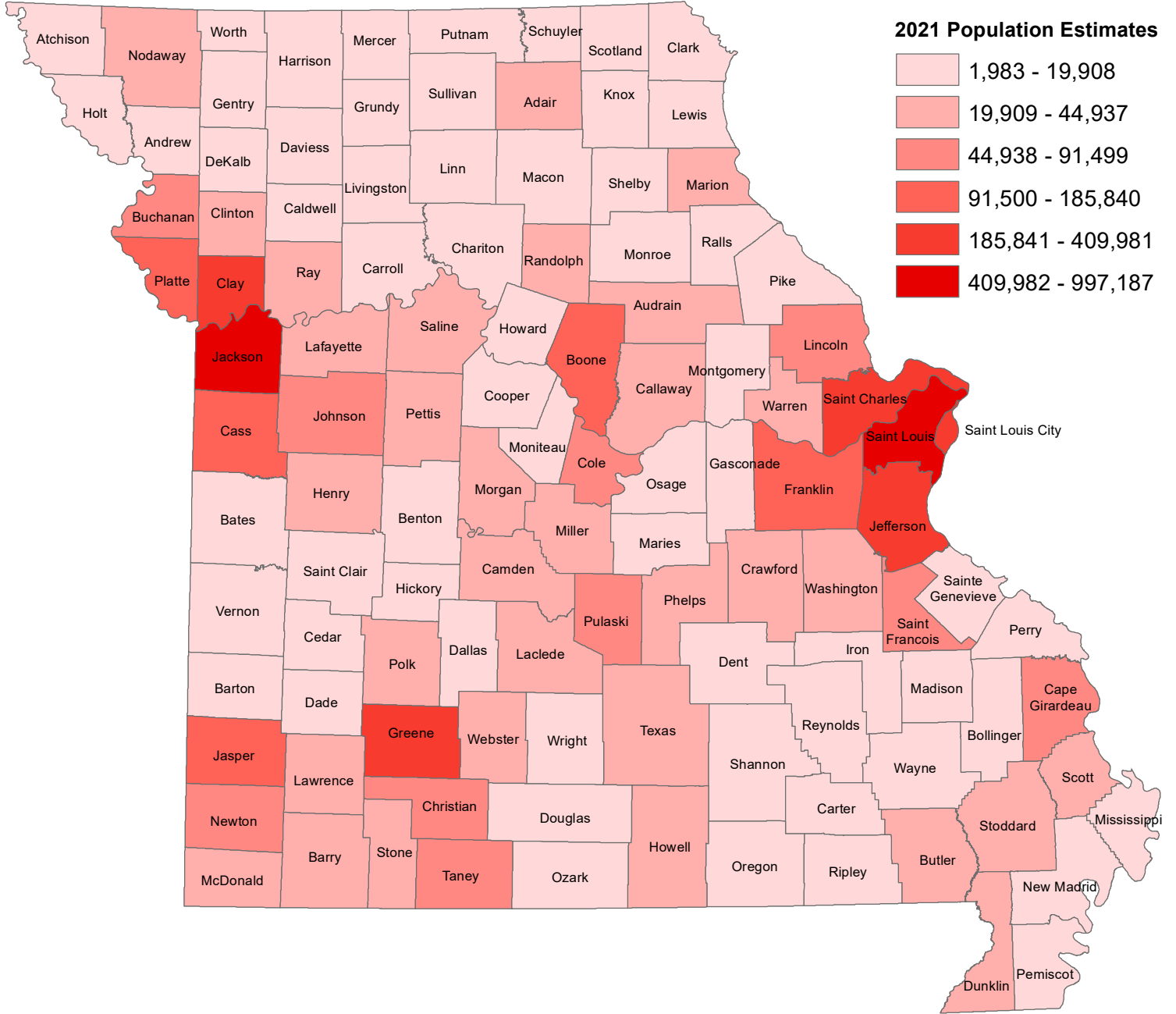

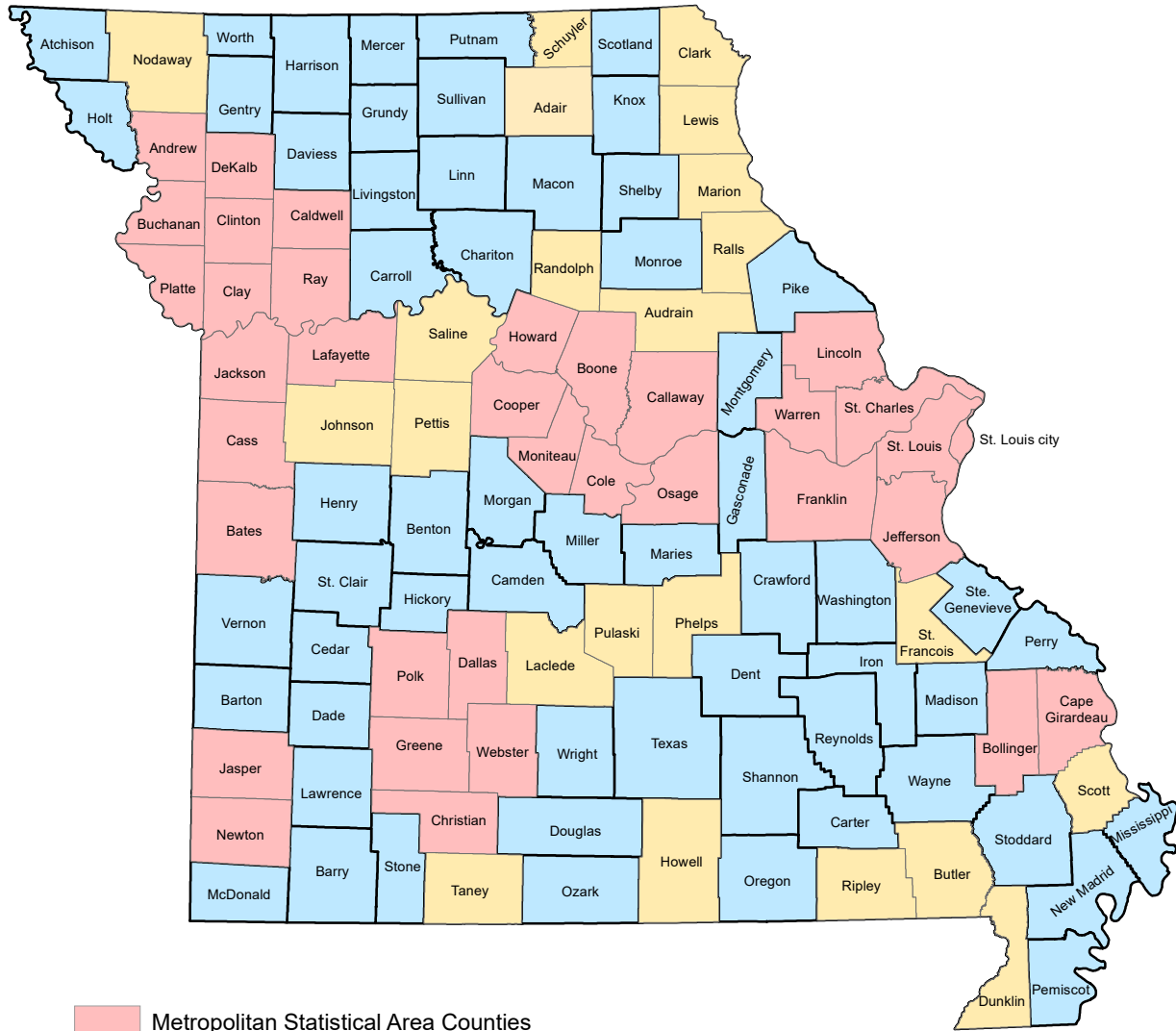
COUNTY POPULATION MAP
