- What is a health home and what can it do for eligible individuals?
 - A health home can help support individuals in managing chronic health conditions, medications, and medical treatments;
 - Assist individuals with meeting their health care goals and provide information about general wellness, healthy eating, or exercise.
 - The health home team will partner with an individual's planning team to identify and address specific health care needs.





The DD Health Home is designed to coordinate care for individuals served through the Division of DD (waiver and non-waiver) with identified health risks and chronic health conditions.

The providers are DD Targeted Case Management and DD HCBS waiver service providers.



MO DD Health Home Eligibility



- Intent is to serve adults and youth with a developmental disability, eligible for Division of DD services, with a Health Risk Screening Tool (HRST) Healthcare Level of 3 or greater, and have one or more chronic health conditions.
- Chronic health condition(s) to include:
 - Diabetes;
 - Asthma;
 - Cardiovascular disease or hypertension;
 - Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD);
 - ♠ Overweight (Body Mass Index (BMI) > 25);
 - P Dementia;
 - Dependent on a ventilator;
 - One or more of the following conditions that places the individual at risk of developing another chronic condition: Pulmonary Aspiration, Bowel Obstruction, Gastroesophageal reflux disease (GERD), Seizures, Sepsis, Dehydration, Tobacco use.
- Diagnosis of Autism Spectrum Disorder





- Individuals will be auto-enrolled in the DD Health Home program.
- Provider Infrastructure

 - Division's 5 Regions





MO DD Health Home Services

MO DD Health Home Providers



Per Member Per Month (PMPM) Rate

- Missouri will pay DD Health Homes the cost of staff primarily responsible for delivery of services not covered by other reimbursement (Health Home Director, Physician Consultant/Nurse Practitioner, Nurse Care Manager, Specialized Healthcare Consultant, and DD Health Home Facilitator), whose duties are not otherwise reimbursable by MO HealthNet. The DD Health Home PMPM includes Health Home specific training, technical assistance, administration, and data analytics.
- All DD Health Home providers will receive the same PMPM rate.



MO DD Health Home Provider Positions



- **Core DD Health Home positions (included in the Per Member Per Month (PMPM) Rate):
 - OD Health Home Director (1 FTE/500 enrollees)
 - Nurse Care Manager (1 FTE/200 enrollees)
 - Physician Consultant/Nurse Practitioner (1 hour/enrollee/year)
 - Specialized Healthcare Consultant (1 hour/enrollee/year)
 - DD Health Home Facilitator (1 FTE/500 enrollees)
- Additional team members may include the individual's primary care physician, as well as other representatives as appropriate to meet the individual's needs.
