### Federal Public Health Emergency Ending May 11, 2023

The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services COVID-19 Federal Public Health Emergency declaration will expire on **Thursday, May 11, 2023**.

The 1135 flexibilities expire upon the termination of the Federal Public Health Emergency, **May 11, 2023**. The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) Appendix K Addendum flexibilities expire no later than six (6) months after the expiration of the Federal Public Health Emergency, **November 11, 2023**. While the State of Emergency in Missouri concluded December 31, 2021, those flexibilities granted under the Appendix K Addendum remain until November 11, 2023.

The COVID-19 [Flexibility Authority Chart](#) has been updated to depict the authority of each of the COVID flexibilities in place. If multiple authorities exist, the flexibility expires at the later of the two dates.
