## **Trauma Informed Practices in Healthcare**

When people come to healthcare settings, they are experiencing questions about their wellbeing. They may have doubt and fear about what doctors, nurses and other healthcare providers are going to find, what the course of treatment is and what the health outcomes might be. When people experience fear, they may act angry, withdrawn, or sad.

This interactive session will increase healthcare providers understanding of the actions of people who have experienced trauma, share signs of emotional dysregulation, and provide practices that are designed to help people stay calm when they are in a dysregulated emotional state.

- Learn about the impact of trauma.
- Explore triggers and behaviors related to traumatic experiences.
- Explore trauma informed practices to support people who have experienced traumatic events.
