Quarterly, Semi-Annual, and Annual Incentive Reporting
Value Based Payment (VBP) Data Collection Quarterly, Semi-Annual, and
Annual Reporting Is Open

The Division of Developmental Disabilities (DD) VBP data collection system is open for *quarterly* reporting for the Health Risk Screening Tool (HRST) RN Rater – Person Centered Thinking, HRST RN Rater – Advanced Fatal Five, Employment Pay for Reporting, Registered Apprenticeship, and Tiered Supports Level of Implementation, for the performance period April 1, 2024 – June 30, 2024. The quarterly reporting period will close **August 15, 2024**. Data must be submitted and in Complete status within REDCap to be eligible for an incentive payment.

Semi-annual reporting for Electronic Visit Verification (EVV), Direct Support Professional (DSP) Training Plan Levels, and Remote Supports is open for the performance period January 1, 2024 – June 30, 2024. The semi-annual reporting period will close **August 15, 2024**. Data must be submitted and in Complete status within REDCap to be eligible for an incentive payment.

Annual reporting for the National Core Indicator (NCI) State of the Workforce (formally 'Staff Stability') Survey VBP incentive is open. The annual reporting period will close **August 15, 2024**. The survey must have been completed in the NCI Survey System by June 30, 2024 **and** the REDCap form submitted in Complete status within REDCap by August 15, 2024 to be eligible for an incentive payment.

The VBP data collection platform, REDCap, captures requests and data entry for the nine approved incentives. REDCap is a secure online data collection tool that can be bookmarked as a website link or added to browser favorites. To request user access, complete the REDCAP User Access Form. Information about the VBP incentives, including data collection and REDCap training, are located on the Division's Value Based Payments webpage.
